HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION S. COUNTRY CLUB RD. BETWEEN E. SUMMIT ST. AND E. ADILENE DR.

The Tucson Police Department is investigating the death of a male located on the city's southeast side.

On January 27, 2016, just before 8:30 p.m., officers from Operations Division South and the Air Unit responded to the area of South Country Club Road between East Summit Street and East Adilene Drive in reference to a report of a deceased male. Officers arrived on scene and located a male with obvious signs of trauma. The male was pronounced deceased on scene at 8:45 p.m.

Detectives from the Tucson Police Department's Homicide Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation. The identity of the victim is unknown. He is described as a Hispanic male, late teens to early twenties, 5'7", 120 – 125lbs. He had a tattoo on his upper left chest with the possible words of "Carrillo". The male was wearing an olive green shirt, black sweatpants and black socks. The shirt contained the wording "Beachweek" and "2013". A photograph of the shirt has been provided.

No suspects have been identified at this time. The investigation is in the early stages and additional information will be released as it becomes available. **The detectives are urging anyone with information to please call 88-CRIME.**
