FATAL PEDESTRIAN COLLISION 1400 BLOCK OF WEST IRVINGTON ROAD

*****UPDATE – APRIL 28, 2015*****

Detectives have continued the investigation surrounding the death of Travis Martinez. They have been able to determine Mr. Martinez sustained multiple injuries but did not suffer gunshot trauma. The injuries Mr. Martinez sustained are consistent with being struck by a vehicle. Detectives from the Traffic Investigations Unit are furthering the investigation. As the investigative efforts continue, detectives are urging anyone with information to please call 911 or 88-CRIME.

The Tucson Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred in the 1400 block of West Irvington Road.

On April 25, 2015, just after 03:30 a.m., officers from Operations Division South responded to a report of a male found in the street that was possibly shot. Upon arrival, officers located an adult male with obvious signs of gunshot trauma. Members from the Tucson Fire Department were on scene and transported the male to Banner University Medical Center with life-threatening injuries. Later this morning, the male succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased. The identity of the victim is being withheld pending next of kin notification.

Detectives responded to the scene to continue the investigation. The investigation is still in the early stages and additional information will be released as it becomes available. Anyone with information is urged to contact 911 or 88-CRIME.
