
MISSING ADULT ENRIQUE SUAREZ

The Tucson Police Department is requesting the public's assistance in locating a missing adult male. On Sunday, May 1, 2016, around 6:45 a.m., 80-year-old Enrique Suarez left his residence in the 2600 block of West Calle Cuero De Vaca (near West Ironwood Hills Drive and North Greasewood Road). He was headed to Chuze Fitness at North Oracle Road and West Wetmore Road but never arrived. He is associated with a burgundy Mercury Villager van bearing Arizona license plate BFC7670. The van has damage to the front passenger side consisting of a broken headlamp and side mirror.

Mr. Suarez has become increasingly forgetful and his family is concerned he may be lost. He is described as a Hispanic male, 5'9", 160lbs with gray hair and brown eyes. He wears prescription glasses. Mr. Suarez was last seen wearing a tan jacket, tan pants and white shoes. If you see Mr. Suarez or have other information please call 911 immediately.
