

MISSING ELDERLY MALE 7500 BLOCK EAST SPEEDWAY BOULEVARD

The Tucson Police Department seeks public assistance with locating a missing elderly male. Officers from Operations Division East responded to a residence in the 7500 block of East Speedway Boulevard on the evening of April 23, 2013. While at the residence, the officers spoke with the wife of the missing male. She advised that shortly after completing their dinner at approximately 6:45 p.m., her husband advised that he was leaving to go to their other house. He quickly left the residence before she was able to stop him. She waited for approximately 2 hours, hoping that he would return on his own, before calling to report him as a missing person. The male has been identified as **85-year old John Satterfield**. He is described as a **Caucasian male, approximately 6'00" tall, weighing approximately 200 pounds, with gray hair and brown eyes**. His hair is styled in a "short crew cut." Mr. Satterfield was last seen **wearing a brown short-sleeved shirt and blue jeans. He also wears glasses**. Mrs. Satterfield advises that Mr. Satterfield left their residence in their vehicle, a **green 1999 Dodge Caravan bearing Arizona license plate 258JVZ**. There is a sticker in the shape of a star on the rear window of the vehicle. There is concern for Mr. Satterfield's welfare due to the fact that he has been diagnosed as having dementia. His wife confirms that they have no other residence in the Tucson area. Several locations throughout Tucson have been checked, including Davis Monthan Air Force Base, where he visits on occasion. However, efforts to locate him have been unsuccessful. It is believed that he may have his wallet with him, allowing him access to money. Anyone having information about his whereabouts is urged to call 911 so that law enforcement personnel can check his welfare and ensure that he receives any needed medical attention prior to being returned home.
