### MISSING ENDANGERED ADULT PAUL GABBARD

**\*\*\*UPDATE – MAY 11, 2014\*\*\***

On the evening of May 9, 2014, Mr. Gabbard was located by staff in the downtown area. He appeared to be in good health, but was taken to a medical facility for evaluation.

The Tucson Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in locating a missing endangered adult. On May 9, 2014, at approximately 5:00 A.M., 48 year-old Paul Gabbard went missing from the Agave Group Home located at 7640 East 29<sup>th</sup> Street. Mr. Gabbard functions at a much younger mental capacity and has multiple medical conditions that require him to take daily medication. Mr. Gabbard does not have his medication with him. He knows how to ride the bus, but employees at the home don't believe he has any money with him. It is unknown what clothing he is wearing because the clothes he slept in were located in his room.

Mr. Gabbard is described as a White male, 5'9, 150 pounds with brown hair. He normally wears dentures, but left those in his room. As we continue our search efforts for Mr. Gabbard, we are asking anyone with information on his whereabouts to contact 911 immediately.
