
MISSING VULNERABLE ADULT FRANCISCO VALENZUELA

The Tucson Police Department is requesting the public's assistance in locating a missing vulnerable adult.

On Wednesday, January 25, 2017, around 5:00 p.m., 88-year-old Francisco Valenzuela left his residence in the 100 block of West Aviation Drive (near West Ajo Way and South 6th Avenue) for an unknown reason. He left in his green Ford Aerostar van bearing Arizona license plate LXJ928. The van is missing the rear bumper and a hub cap. Mr. Valenzuela went missing around the same time last year and was located in the early morning hours with his vehicle in the area of E. Broadway Blvd. / N. Wilmot Rd. by a citizen. Mr. Valenzuela is a retired bus driver and may have been driving his old route.

Mr. Valenzuela has Dementia. He also requires medication where if not taken can result in serious illness. He is described as a Hispanic male, 5'7", 160lbs with gray hair, brown eyes and a gray beard. He wears wire trim glasses. He was last seen wearing a gray sweater and blue jeans.
