MISSING VULNERABLE ADULT

*****UPDATE – AUGUST 30, 2012*****

The Tucson Police Department is happy to report that Mr. Jeffrey Gervan was located in Operations Division South on the late afternoon of August 30, 2012. He was in good health and will be returned to his residence. Thank you to all who assisted with locating him.

The Tucson Police Department seeks public assistance with locating a **missing vulnerable adult**. **Jeffrey Gervan, 64-years old, is mentally challenged and operates at a 5-6 year old level.** He walked away from a store in the 200 block of West Prince Road at approximately 10:45 a.m. on August 30, 2012. Employees at the store were able to confirm via video surveillance that Mr. Gervan left the store by himself. There is heightened concern for his welfare due to the high temperatures and other environmental factors. Tucson Police Department personnel have searched extensively throughout the day on August 30, 2012 in an effort to locate Mr. Gervan, but have had no success as of yet.

Mr. Gervan is described as a **Caucasian male, 5'10" tall, weighing 150 pounds, with black hair and brown eyes.** He was last seen wearing a **blue baseball cap, green polo shirt, and blue jean shorts.** Anyone having information about his whereabouts is urged to call 911.
