MURDER / SUICIDE INVESTIGATION 5900 BLOCK OF SOUTH RANDALL BOULEVARD

*****UPDATE- OCTOBER 26, 2013*****

The names of the two individuals involved in this morning's murder/suicide have been released. The female involved in the incident was identified as 35-year old Alicia Carrillo. The male was identified as 34-year old Daniel Ornelas. Next of kin have been notified.

Sergeant Chris Widmer – October 26, 2013

On October 26, 2013, at 12:52 a.m., officers from Operations Division South responded to a report of a check welfare at a residence in the 5900 block of South Randall Boulevard. The caller advised 911 that a male and female were inside the residence and appeared to be deceased. Upon arrival, officers located a 35-year old female and a 34-year old male with obvious signs of trauma. Both were pronounced deceased at the scene.

Homicide Detectives responded to continue the investigation. They spoke to family members and examined physical evidence at the scene. They discovered that the male and female had a domestic relationship. The male lived at the home and the female was there visiting. Family members of both the male and the female became concerned after they were unable to contact either of them throughout the evening. Members of both families went to the home to check their welfare and discovered their bodies inside the residence. Detectives discovered gunshot trauma to the male and a handgun near his body. Detectives were unable to definitively determine the cause of death to the female, but are looking into the possibility that she was strangled. The preliminary findings indicate that the male murdered the female then shot and killed himself. Detectives are investigating the incident as a murder/suicide.
