2013 NATIONAL PRESCRIPTION TAKE-BACK INITIATIVE

The Tucson Police Department will be participating in the “Drug Enforcement Administrations 2013 National Prescription Take-back Initiative”. On Saturday, April 27, 2013, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., the Tucson Police Department will host two locations for prescription medications to be dropped off. The first location is the Eastside Police Service Center located at 9670 East Golf Links Road, and the second location is the Westside Police Service Center located at 1310 West Miracle Mile. Items that will be accepted include: prescription and over-counter tablets, capsules, and creams. Several items, including glass containers, inhalers, sharps/needles, or I.V. medications will not be accepted. Illicit drugs are not a part of this initiative. Additionally, for safety and confidentiality reasons, items that are dropped off for disposal cannot be returned.

This event is intended to be entirely confidential in nature. As such, there is no requirement to provide identification in order to dispose of medications. The service operates on a “no questions asked” basis, ensuring anonymity. There is also no cost to participate in the event.

Historically, many dispose of expired or unused medications by simply throwing them in the garbage, pouring them down the drain, or flushing them down the toilet. Along with inherent environmental concerns that could result as these medications seep into the ground or waterways, there is also a significant concern that the medications could end up in the wrong hands, creating a very dangerous situation for anyone that ingests medications not prescribed to them. Instead of running such risks, plan to take advantage of this free and anonymous program to dispose of your expired or unused medications.
