PROHIBITED POSSESSOR ARREST

On March 20, 2013, The Tucson Police Department's Major Theft Offenders Unit initiated an investigation into an individual who was pawning and selling numerous firearms in the Tucson area. Detectives identified the individual as 45-year old Dwayne Wynne. Further investigation revealed the Mr. Wynne was a prohibited possessor, as he has a previous felony conviction. Detectives retrieved over 40 firearms that Mr. Wynne had pawned or sold at various pawnshops and gun stores throughout Tucson. On March 21st, detectives served a search warrant at Mr. Wynne's residence in the 2200 block of East Hedrick Drive. Seven more firearms as well as a small amount of methamphetamines and drug paraphernalia were seized from the residence. Mr. Wynne was booked into the Pima County Jail for 60 counts of Prohibited Possessor. Further charges are pending.
