ARMED ROBBERY

***** UPDATE – August 26, 2011 *****

On August 18, 2011, a joint team of officers, deputies, and detectives from the Tucson Police Department and Pima County Sheriff's Department located and arrested **18-year old Joseph Slay-Hernandez** in connection with several robbery investigations.

Through the examination of forensic evidence, the Pima County Sheriff's Department identified Slay-Hernandez as a suspect in the robbery of the Gas City at 6150 S. Kolb Road. Personnel from the Tucson Police Department's Surveillance and Robbery Units assisted the Sheriff's Department Robbery and Assault Team with locating and detaining Slay-Hernandez at his mother's residence in the 7400 block of East Benson Highway. Following interviews by investigators from both agencies, he was arrested and booked into the Pima County Jail.

Slay-Hernandez was charged with **four counts of Aggravated Assault, three counts of Aggravated Robbery, three counts of Armed Robbery, and one count of Kidnapping, all felonies**, in connection with the three cases occurring within Tucson city limits (Circle K stores on Speedway and Silverbell, and Quik Mart on Wilmot). He was charged by the Pima County Sheriff's Department with **one count each of Armed Robbery, Aggravated Robbery, Aggravated Assault, and Kidnapping** in connection with the case on South Kolb Road.

On May 28, 2011, in addition to the charges filed by the Tucson Police Department, the Pima County Sheriff's Department charged Randy Milliner with **one count each of Armed Robbery, Aggravated Robbery, Aggravated Assault, and Kidnapping** in connection with the Kolb Road case when he was booked into the Pima County Jail.

On May 28, 2011, Robbery Unit detectives arrested **18-year old Randy Milliner**, of Tucson in connection with these cases. Milliner was identified by a citizen who recognized him from media broadcasts of the surveillance footage that was released on May 27th. Milliner was booked into the Pima County Jail on **3 counts each of Armed Robbery, Aggravated Robbery, and Aggravated Assault**, all felonies.

Detectives are still seeking to identify and locate the other two suspects in these cases, described as a **Hispanic or Caucasian male, 18-25 years of age, approximately 5'7" tall, 160 pounds, wearing a brown t-shirt and jean shorts**, and an **African-American male, 18-25 year of age, approximately 5'8" tall, 180 pounds, wearing a black t-shirt and dark blue or black jeans with a black baseball hat that has a white "B" on the front.**

On May 26, 2011 beginning at 2:07 a.m. three males began a series of robberies at various locations. At 2:07 a.m., three males entered the Circle K at 1735 W. Speedway Blvd. and demanded money and items from the clerk at gunpoint. At 3:29 p.m. the same three males entered the Circle K located at 2405 N. Silverbell Rd and the same male which is described as a Hispanic or White male, 18-25 years old, 5'7", 160 pounds wearing a brown t-shirt and jean shorts produced a handgun and threatened the clerk. The three males left the business with an undisclosed amount of money and miscellaneous items. Shortly after that at approximately 4:14 a.m., the same three males entered the Quik Mart located at 3499 S. Wilmot Rd where the same male threatened the clerk with a gun while all three males got away with an undisclosed amount

of money and miscellaneous items. The same three males are connected to a robbery that occurred in the county at Gas City at 6150 S. Kolb Rd.

The males are described as: **Suspect #1** is a **Hispanic or White male, 18-25 years old, 5'7", 160 pounds wearing a brown t-shirt and jean shorts.** **Suspect #2** is a **Black male, 18-25 years old, 5'8" –5'10", 180 pounds wearing a black button up shirt, and black and white plaid shorts.** **Suspect #3** is a **Black male, 18-25 year of age, 5'8", 180 pounds wearing a black t-shirt and black jeans with a baseball hat.**

The Tucson Police Department Robbery Unit is seeking the public's assistance in identifying and locating the suspects. Anyone with information regarding the identity of the suspects or further information on any of the robberies is urged to call **911** or **88-CRIME**.
