ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY - ROBBERY SUSPECT 4711 EAST SPEEDWAY – CHASE BANK

The Tucson Police Department is seeking public assistance with identifying a suspect involved in the robbery of a Chase Bank branch at 4711 East Speedway at approximately 11:40 this morning. The suspect entered the branch and confronted the victim teller. Although no weapons were displayed, the suspect was verbally abusive and threatened violence if the teller did not comply. The suspect robbed the bank of an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency and walked out after putting the money in a bag that he had brought with him.

The suspect is described as a **Caucasian male** in his **mid to late 20's**, **approximately 5'10 tall, 170-180 pounds, with brown hair**. He was last seen wearing a **navy blue hooded sweatshirt and a grey baseball cap with a Nike "Swoosh" emblem on the side, and carrying a brown and tan satchel**.

The Tucson Police Department urges anyone with information about this incident, or this suspect, to call **911** or **88-CRIME**.
