## ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY - ROBBERY SUSPECT

The Tucson Police Department is seeking public assistance with locating a suspect believed to be responsible for at least three armed robbery incidents over the past three nights. In each of the below incidents, the **suspect has pointed a handgun at the victims.**

- On October 2, 2011 at approximately 7:45 p.m., the suspect robbed the Giant Express convenience store at the southeast corner of East Broadway Boulevard and South Houghton Road.
- On October 3, 2011 at approximately 6:15 p.m., the suspect robbed the Walgreens store on the northeast corner of East Broadway and South Houghton.
- On October 4, 2011 at approximately 7:50 p.m., the suspect robbed the Quik Mart on the northwest corner of East 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and South Houghton.

The suspect is described as a **Caucasian male, 18-22 years old, approximately 5'10" to 6'02" tall, 140-170 pounds, with red hair and freckles and/or pock marked skin.** The suspect vehicle is described as a **late-90's model, brown or champagne colored Kia 4-door sedan.** There may have been as many as four additional subjects inside the vehicle during at least one of the incidents.

The Tucson Police Department urges anyone with information about these cases or about this suspect and vehicle to call **911** or **88-CRIME**.
