ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY ARMED OXYCODONE ROBBER

*****UPDATE – JUNE 10, 2012*****

Officers from the South Tucson Police Department located Robert F. Gutierrez on the early morning of June 9, 2012. He was subsequently arrested for various robbery related offenses. Pursuant to the warrant that had been issued for his arrest, Mr. Gutierrez was charged with **3 counts of Armed Robbery, 1 count of Attempted Armed Robbery, and 1 count of Attempted Robbery, all felony offenses.** He was transported and booked into the Pima County Jail. A booking photograph is not yet available.

*****UPDATE – JUNE 8, 2012*****

The male suspected of committing 5 different armed robbery offenses between February 10, 2012 and May 30, 2012 has been identified. Thanks to an **88-Crime tip**, detectives determined that **Robert F. Gutierrez, 57-years old**, is the male that committed each of the crimes. A warrant has been issued for his arrest in relation to the different robbery incidents. Mr. Gutierrez is described as a **Hispanic male, 5'07" tall, weighing 160 pounds, with black hair and brown eyes.** Anyone having information about his whereabouts is urged to call **911 or 88-Crime.** A photograph of Mr. Gutierrez is included below.

Sergeant Maria Hawke – June 8, 2012

Detectives with the Robbery Unit of the Tucson Police Department seek public assistance with identifying an unknown male, who is the suspect in **five different incidents of armed robbery** that have occurred thus far in 2012. The male has committed robbery offenses in both the west side of Tucson as well as the south side of Tucson. The first four incidents occurred between the dates of February 10, 2012 and March 6, 2012. The most recent incident occurred on May 30, 2012. At approximately 9:25 p.m. on May 30, 2012, the unknown male entered the Walgreen's store located at 2411 North Oracle Road. He made his way to the pharmacy counter and displayed a handgun to the clerk. The suspect **demanding and was given an undisclosed amount of oxycodone** before he left the store. In each of the previous four incidents, the manner in which the robbery was committed was very similar. In addition, video surveillance of the male was captured in each incident.

The suspect has been described as a **Hispanic male in his late 40s to early 50s**. He is **between 5'05" and 5'09" tall and weighs approximately 175 pounds**. His build has been described as **stocky or muscular**. In addition, he is believed to have **brown eyes, brown hair with gray hair mixed throughout, and a bushy mustache**. In every instance he has worn a sweatshirt and jeans.

Photographs obtained from surveillance video of some of the incidents are included below. Anyone having information about the suspect's identity is urged to call **911 or 88-Crime**.
