## ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY ATTEMPTED ROBBERY SUSPECTS

The Tucson Police Department is seeking public assistance with identifying and locating two suspects believed to be responsible for at least three attempted robbery incidents that occurred on November 15, 2011.

At approximately 11:22 a.m. on November 15, 2011, the Tucson Police Department was notified via a 911 call of an attempted robbery incident that occurred at the **Compass Bank** located at **7880 East Broadway**. Officers from Operations Division East responded to the location to investigate the incident. They learned that an unknown adult male entered the bank and proceeded to the teller counter. He became frustrated when speaking to the teller and left the bank without obtaining any money. Minutes later, at approximately 11:44 a.m., a suspect matching the description of the male that entered the bank, walked into the **Wing Stop** restaurant located at **7940 East Broadway**. He told the employees that he was robbing the business, but quickly left when they refused to give him any money. The suspect was described as a **Caucasian male in his mid to late 20's, 5'05" to 5'05" tall, 170 to 180 lbs, with a medium build, dirty blond hair, green eyes, and both a mustache and goatee**. He was last seen wearing a **black shirt, black pants, white tennis shoes, and a red and white "Indian's" baseball hat**. Images of the male suspect are included below.

Later in the day, at approximately 2:34 p.m. on November 15, 2011, the Tucson Police Department received a 911 call reporting an attempted robbery incident at the **Compass Bank** located inside of the Albertson's grocery store at **2854 North Campbell**. Officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to the location to conduct an investigation. They learned that a female suspect, described as a **Hispanic female, in her early 50's, approximately 5'07" tall, 210 pounds, with black hair**, entered the Albertson's and proceeded to the Compass Bank counter. The female was wearing a **white or gray sweatshirt with the "Nike" wording and symbol on the front**. She remained on the telephone as she approached the counter and handed the teller a note demanding money from the bank. The teller took the note and walked to a back office to call 911. The female suspect then left the bank area and exited the grocery store. Witnesses reported seeing a female similar in description to the suspect hiding amongst cars in the parking lot before possibly getting into an **older model, red Jeep CJ7**.
