### ATTEMPT TO IDENTIFY NORTH CAMPBELL AVENUE SERIAL ROBBER

The Tucson Police Department seeks public assistance with locating a serial robber who is responsible for five recent robbery incidents that occurred at various businesses along North Campbell Avenue. The first incident occurred on **April 12, 2012**. An unknown male subject entered the **Pizza Hut restaurant located at 2943 North Campbell Avenue** just before 3:15 p.m. Upon entering the business, the subject made contact with one of the restaurant employees. He displayed a handgun to the employee and demanded the money from the register. After the male was given an undisclosed amount of money, he left the business. A witness reported seeing a **small Silver Pick-Up Truck** leaving the area quickly after the incident.

On **April 13, 2012** at approximately 4:49 p.m. an unknown male entered the **Family Dollar Store located at 3603 North Campbell Avenue**. He approached a clerk with an item to purchase. When the item was rung up, the suspect pulled out a handgun, displaying it to the clerk, and demanded the money from the register. The suspect was given an undisclosed amount of money and left the business.

The next incident occurred on **April 17, 2012** at approximately 11:18 a.m. at the **Ace Hardware store located at 2830 North Campbell Avenue**. An unknown male entered the business and approached the clerk with an item to purchase. When the item was rung up, the suspect displayed a handgun to the clerk and demanded the money from the register. The suspect was given an undisclosed amount of money and left the business. A witness in the area observed the suspect get into a **small, 2-door pick up truck that was silver in color**. He was last seen headed eastbound on East Glenn.

On **May 19, 2012**, an unknown male entered the **Subway restaurant located at 3250 North Campbell Avenue** at approximately 10:20 a.m. After entering the business, the male ordered a drink. When the clerk rang up the drink, the suspect pulled out a handgun, displaying it to the clerk, and demanded the money from the register. The suspect was given an undisclosed amount of money and left the business.

Lastly, on **May 22, 2012**, another robbery occurred at the **Walgreen's store located at 1900 East Grant Road** at approximately 4:59 p.m. An unknown male entered the business and selected an item to purchase. After the item was rung up, the suspect displayed a handgun to the clerk and demanded the money from the register. Once again, he was given an undisclosed amount of money and left the business.

The male is described as a **Caucasian male, 35 to 40 years of age, 5'11" to 6'01" tall, and weighing 170 to 180 pounds.** Some witnesses have indicated that he **might be unshaven.** Photographs obtained from video surveillance footage of each incident are included below.
