### **BANK ROBBERY ARREST 280 NORTH PANTANO ROAD**

At approximately 2:14 p.m. on the afternoon of April 23, 2012, the Tucson Police Department was advised of a bank robbery that had just occurred at the **Hughes Federal Credit Union located at 280 North Pantano Road**. Officers from Operations Division East responded to the bank, arriving within approximately 5 minutes of the original 911 call. Upon arrival, officers immediately determined that no employees or customers of the bank were injured. They also determined that the suspect had left prior to police arrival. She was last seen leaving the bank on foot in a southbound direction.

Detectives with the Robbery Unit responded to the bank to further the investigation. They examined evidence and conducted interviews with persons that had been present in the bank when the robbery incident occurred. The detectives learned that a female entered the bank and presented a note to the victim teller, demanding money and threatening harm. After being given an undisclosed amount of money, the female left the bank. Some of the other employees in the bank recognized the female and were able to provide police personnel with her name and address. Officers were able to conduct follow up and locate the female at her residence, which was nearby. The female was identified as **26-year old Stephanie Connor**. She was arrested, transported, and booked into the Pima County Jail for **1 count of Robbery, a felony**. A booking photograph is included below.
