### **BANK ROBBERY HUGHES FEDERAL CREDIT UNION 3131 EAST SPEEDWAY BOULEVARD**

On April 13, 2012 at approximately 10:58 a.m., officers from Tucson Police Department's Midtown Division responded to a report of robbery at the Hughes Federal Credit Union, located at 3131 East Speedway Boulevard. Officers arrived at the credit union within five minutes of the initial call and learned that the suspect had fled east from the bank. Officers initiated a search of the area surrounding the credit union but were unable to locate the suspect.

Detectives from the Robbery Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation. Bank employees reported the suspect entered the bank and waited in the teller line. Upon approaching the teller window, the male demanded money and fled after receiving an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency. No weapons were seen.

Robbery Unit Detectives obtained the suspect's description and are seeking the public's assistance in identifying him. He is described as a **White male, in his early 40's, 5'10" to 6'0" tall, 180 pounds, with blonde hair.** He was last seen wearing a **dark long sleeve shirt, blue jeans, white tennis shoes, a white cap with "PING" on the front, and dark sunglasses.** The Tucson Police Department urges anyone with information about the identity of suspect and his whereabouts to call **911** or **88-CRIME**.
