## SOUTHERN ARIZONA DUI TASK FORCE THANKSGIVING WEEKEND DEPLOYMENT STATISTICS

The Southern Arizona DUI Task Force deployed from 8:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m., Thursday through Saturday, November 24<sup>th</sup> to the 26<sup>th</sup> in the Tucson - Pima County area to detect, investigate, and remove those drivers found to be impaired to the *slightest degree* from the use of alcohol and/or drugs on the public highways and streets of the community.

The below statistics were produced by officers deployed from the following agencies: Tucson Police Department, Pima County Sheriff's Department, University of Arizona Police Department, Arizona Department of Public Safety, Oro Valley Police Department and Marana Police Department.
