DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND ATTEMPTED HOMICIDE 2800 BLOCK EAST CALLE RABIDA

At approximately 2:10 p.m. on April 5, 2012 the Tucson Police Department received a 911 call regarding a domestic violence incident that occurred at a residence in the 2800 Block of East Calle Rabida. Officers from Operations Division South responded to the area, arriving within approximately 5 minutes of their original dispatch. The initial information that was received indicated that a female and her children had run to a neighbor's house to call 911 after her estranged husband attacked her. The female was injured during the course of the altercation with her husband. She was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. None of the children were injured.

Detectives from the Domestic Violence Unit responded to the scene in order to further the investigation. They learned that the female was home with her children on the early afternoon of April 5, 2012. Her estranged husband, later identified as Jose Raul Juarez-Orci (26-years of age), arrived at the residence while they were there. He had not been staying at the residence, and the female had obtained an Order of Protection against him. The Order of Protection did specifically prohibit Mr. Juarez-Orci from being at the residence. Mr. Juarez-Orci forced entry into the residence and physically attacked his wife, injuring her with a deadly weapon. She was able to escape from him and the residence with her children and run to a neighbor's house for help. Mr. Juarez-Orci fled the area prior to police arrival and was not located.

A warrant for the arrest of Mr. Juarez-Orci was obtained, charging him with **1 count of Attempted Homicide, 1 count of First Degree Burglary, and 4 counts of Domestic Violence Aggravated Assault, including one count of Domestic Violence Aggravated Assault Against a Person Protected by an Order of Protection.** All of the offenses are felonies. He is described as a **Hispanic male, 5'08" tall, weighing 170 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes.**

The Tucson Police Department seeks assistance with locating Mr. Juarez-Orci. Anyone having information about his whereabouts is urged to call **911 or 88-Crime.** Photographs of Mr. Juarez-Orci are included below.
