HOMICIDE 200 BLOCK OF EAST PASTIME ROAD ***UPDATE 2 – MARCH 25, 2012***

An arrest has been made reference this investigation. **Thomas Warren, 23-years old**, was arrested for **1 count of First Degree Murder** as a result of the investigation into the stabbing death of Clinton Myers (21-years old). Mr. Warren was transported and booked into the Pima County Jail. His picture is not yet available for release, as detectives have not yet completed their investigation.

UPDATE - MARCH 25, 2012

The victim of the stabbing incident that occurred at a residence in the 200 Block of East Pastime on the evening of March 22, 2012 has been identified as **21-year old Clinton Myers**. Next of kin have been identified. Detectives continue working diligently to identify all parties involved and the motive for the crime. Anyone with information about the incident is encouraged to call **911 or 88-Crime**.

Sergeant Maria Hawke – March 25, 2012

On March 22, 2012 at approximately 7:20 p.m., the Tucson Police Department received a 911 call from a citizen reporting a fight and a possible stabbing. Officers from Operations Division West responded to the residence and were on scene within three minutes. Officers found the victim, described as a Caucasian male in his 20's, suffering from a severe laceration. He was transported to a local trauma center where he succumbed to his injuries shortly before midnight. The victim has not been positively identified, and next of kin have not yet been notified.

Detectives from the Aggravated Assault Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation. Detectives examined and collected evidence, and interviewed witnesses. Detectives have determined that the victim and another male were involved in a physical confrontation inside a residence. The female resident called 911 after breaking up the

confrontation and observing that one of the males was bleeding heavily. The suspect fled from the scene on foot prior to officers arriving on scene.

The investigation is ongoing at this time as detectives work to determine a motive for the crime and to locate the suspect responsible.

The Tucson Police Department urges anyone with information about this crime to call **911** or **88-CRIME**.
