MISSING ADULT 700 BLOCK NORTH ARCADIA

At approximately 8:28 a.m. on July 14, 2012, the Tucson Police Department received a 911 call indicating that an adult male was missing from his residence in the **700 block of North Arcadia**. Officers from Operations Division Midtown responded to the residence to obtain additional information. Upon arrival, they learned that **Hal Ridley (18-years old)** had left his house between 7:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on July 14, 2012. He is described as an **African-American male, 5'08" tall, weighing approximately 250 pounds, with brown hair and brown eyes**. Mr. Ridley has various medical concerns, including a **need for daily insulin shots**. He also operates at an age younger than 18 years of age. It is believed that he may have a small amount of money with him. Additionally, he has a bus pass and is familiar with using the Sun Tran bus system. His direction of travel and clothing are unknown.

Tucson Police Department personnel have searched extensively for Mr. Ridley throughout the day on July 14, 2012 and seek public assistance with locating him. Anyone having information about his whereabouts is asked to call 911 as soon as possible so that he can get the medical care he needs and be returned home safely.
