### **RESIDENTIAL ROBBERY AND AGGRAVATED ASSAULT 2300 BLOCK OF EAST CAMERON VISTA**

On March 22, 2012 at approximately 7:35 p.m., the Tucson Police Department received a 911 call from a woman who stated that she had been shot at her residence. Officers from Operations Division South responded and were on scene within four minutes of the initial call. Officers located the victim, a female in her 60's, who was suffering from apparent gunshot trauma. She was transported to a local trauma center in serious condition, but is expected to survive her injuries.

Officers determined that the victim was home alone when she heard noises in the house. As she was investigating the source of the noise, she observed several suspects fleeing through the front yard carrying property from the residence. One of the suspects fired a shot, or shots, at the victim just after she exited the doorway, striking her at least once. The suspects then fled from the area and were last seen running westbound.

Detectives from the Night Detectives Unit responded to the scene to continue the investigation. Detectives interviewed witnesses and examined and collected evidence. The investigation is ongoing at this time as detectives work to determine a motive for the crime and to identify and locate the suspects responsible.
