SHOOTING INCIDENT 5120 EAST SPEEDWAY

*****UPDATE – JANUARY 1, 2013*****

As a result of the investigation thus far, an arrest has been made relating to the shooting incident that occurred at 5120 East Speedway at approximately 2:11 a.m. on December 30, 2012. **Daniel A. Rodriguez, 32-years old**, was arrested and charged with **1 count of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, 1 count of Discharging a Firearm at an Occupied Structure in Furtherance of a Gang, 1 count of Prohibited Possessor, and 1 count of Tampering with Evidence, all felony offenses.** He was transported and booked into the Pima County Jail. A booking photograph is not available for release at this time for investigative reasons. The detectives will continue working on this investigation, and additional updates will be forthcoming when the information becomes available.

*****UPDATE – DECEMBER 31, 2012*****

The adult male, who received life threatening gunshot trauma during the incident at 5120 East Speedway on the early morning of December 30, 2012, succumbed to his injuries while at the hospital and was pronounced deceased. He has been identified as **Anthony Holguin, 32-years old.** Next of kin have been notified. Detectives continue their investigation into this incident. Anyone having information regarding the shooting that occurred at the Ten's Showclub on the early morning of December 30, 2012 is asked **to call 911 or 88-Crime.**

The Tucson Police Department was notified of a shooting incident that happened in the parking lot of the Ten's Showclub located at **5120 East Speedway** at approximately 2:11 a.m. on December 30, 2012. Officers from Operations Division Midtown and Operations Division East responded to the location in order to initiate an investigation. Upon arrival, they found a **32-year old male**, who was suffering from obvious signs of gunshot trauma. Emergency medical personnel from the Tucson Fire Department also responded and transported the male to a local hospital for additional emergency medical treatment. The male's injuries were deemed to be life threatening in nature. No other injured persons were located at the

Detectives from the Gang Investigations Unit responded to assist with the examination surrounding the circumstances of the shooting incident due to the fact that there were indications that at least one of the involved parties may have had gang affiliations. The initial investigation indicated that an altercation transpired between two different groups of people in the parking lot of the Ten's Showclub. The altercation began shortly after 2:00 a.m. What initially began as a verbal confrontation quickly escalated to a physical fight and ultimately ended with several shots fired. Immediately after the shots were fired, a **white sport utility vehicle (SUV)** was seen leaving the parking lot at a high rate of speed. Responding officers saw the vehicle as it was leaving and began to follow it. The vehicle came to a stop near the intersection of East Rosewood and North Magnolia. An unknown number of occupants fled from the vehicle. Officers began searching for the occupant(s) of the SUV. With the assistance of a K9 Unit, one male, who was believed to have been in the SUV, was located a short distance away in the 800 Block of North Rosemont. He was detained for investigative purposes.

There were approximately 40 to 45 persons inside of the establishment when the shooting incident occurred. There were also an unknown number of persons outside of the business at the time that the incident initiated. The investigation continues at this time to determine the cause of the initial altercation and subsequent shooting as well as to determine the identity of all involved parties. Detectives request that anyone having information about the incident please **call 911 or 88-Crime**.
