SOUTHERN ARIZONA DUI TASK FORCE HOLIDAY DUI ENFORCEMENT AND SOBER DESIGNATED DRIVER CAMPAIGN KICKOFF

The Southern Arizona DUI Task Force invites the public and the media to attend its annual Holiday DUI Enforcement and Sober Designated Driver Campaign Kickoff in Tucson on November 30, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. The event will take place on the southeast side of the Tucson Convention Center.

Law enforcement officers from agencies throughout southern Arizona will be present at this year's holiday enforcement kickoff, which serves as an opportunity to educate the communities of Southern Arizona about the dangers of impaired driving and the increased risks associated with the time period between Thanksgiving and New Year's Day.
