



17TH Annual Southwest Police Motorcycle Training Competition April 19-20, 2013

The Tucson Police Department is proud to be hosting the 17th Annual Southwest Police Motorcycle Training Competition (SPMTC). This event is an opportunity for Police Motorcycle officers from around the country to get together to share training ideas and promote quality Motorcycle Officer Training. SPMTC is a fundraiser for Law Enforcement Torch Run / Special Olympics Arizona.

This year's event will be held at Park Place Mall, 5870 E. Broadway Blvd., Tucson, AZ. Friday, April 19 is the practice day and Saturday, April 20 will be the competition. Activities both days will start at approximately 7:00 AM and conclude around 4:00 PM.

The training and competition will be limited to the first 110 applicants so please get your applications in early. The application fee is \$65.00. Registration includes one meal ticket for the Awards Banquet on Saturday evening and an event T-Shirt. Additional banquet tickets may be purchased for \$30.00 each (child banquet ticket \$18.00) and extra shirts will be \$10 each.
