## STABLE VALUE/MONEY MARKET FUNDS

**VantageTrust PLUS Fund** - The PLUS Fund seeks to offer a competitive level of income consistent with providing capital preservation and meeting liquidity needs. The PLUS Fund seeks to achieve returns higher than those of money market funds and short-term bank rates over the long run. A key goal is to provide capital preservation by limiting the risk of loss of principal and delivering stable returns. Additionally, the PLUS Fund is designed to meet the liquidity needs of Plan participants that invest in the PLUS Fund.

## BOND FUNDS

**Vanguard Total Bond Market Index Fund Class Signal - MC: Intermediate-Term Bond** The investment seeks to track the performance of a broad, market-weighted bond index. The fund employs a "passive management", or indexing investment approach designed to track the performance of the Barclays Capital U.S. Aggregate Float Adjusted index. It invests by sampling the index. It invests at least 80% of assets in bonds held in the index. The fund maintains a dollar-weighted average maturity consistent with that of the index, ranging between 5 and 10 years.

**VT PIMCO Total Return Fund Class Administrative - MC: Intermediate-Term Bond** The investment seeks maximum total return. The fund normally invests at least 65% of assets in a diversified portfolio of Fixed-Income Instruments of varying maturities, which may be represented by forwards or derivatives such as options, futures contracts, or swap agreements. It invests primarily in investment-grade debt securities, but may invest up to 10% of total assets in high-yield securities ("junk bonds"). The fund may invest all assets in derivative instruments, such as options, futures contracts or swap agreements, or in mortgage- or asset-backed securities.

**VT PIMCO High Yield Fund Class Administrative - MC: High Yield Bond** The investment seeks total return consistent with preservation of capital. The Fund invests at least 80% of assets in a diversified portfolio of high-yield securities ("junk bonds"). It may invest the remainder of the assets in investment-grade Fixed-Income Instruments. The average portfolio duration of this fund normally varies from two to six years based on PIMCO's forecast for interest rates.

**Oppenheimer International Bond Fund - MC: World Bond** The investment seeks total return with a secondary objective of income consistent with total return. The fund invests mainly

in debt securities of foreign government and corporate issuers. It normally invests at least 80% of assets in bonds and at least in three countries other than the United States. The fund does not limit its investments to securities of issuers in a particular market capitalization or maturity range or rating category. It is nondiversified.

## BALANCED/ASSET ALLOCATION FUNDS

**Milestone Funds** - The Milestone Funds seek a different degree of potential risk and return by diversifying among various Vantagepoint Funds in differing allocations. These funds are designed to allow investors to select one fund that offers asset allocation, fund selection, and rebalancing appropriate for their respective time period of investment.

**Model Portfolio Funds** - The Vantagepoint Model Portfolio Funds seek long-term total return from income and capital gains. The five Funds vary by risk level and, therefore, by return potential. Each Fund invests in a specific target allocation of Vantagepoint Funds that is regularly monitored and periodically rebalanced with the goal of ensuring a consistent risk-return profile. Each Model Portfolio Fund is designed to offer investors a complete investment program, depending on their needs.

## U.S. STOCK FUNDS

**VT Vantagepoint Equity Income Fund - MC: Large Value** The investment objective of the Vantagepoint Equity Income Fund is to offer long-term capital growth with consistency derived from dividend yield.

**VT RiverSource Diversified Equity Income Fund Class R4 - MC: Large Value** The investment seeks a high level of current income with a secondary consideration of steady growth of capital. The fund normally invests at least 80% of assets in dividend-paying common and preferred stocks. It may invest up to 25% of assets in foreign investments. The fund may invest in any economic sector and may emphasize one or more particular sectors.

**Vanguard 500 Index Fund Class Signal - MC: Large Blend** The investment seeks to track the performance of a benchmark index that measures the investment return of large-capitalization stocks. The fund employs a passive management investment approach designed to track the performance of the Standard & Poor's 500 index, a widely recognized benchmark of U.S. stock market performance that is dominated by the stocks of large U.S. companies. It invests all, or substantially all, of assets in the stocks that make up the index, holding each stock in approximately the same proportion as its weighting in the index.

**Neuberger Berman Socially Responsive Fund Class Trust - MC: Large Blend** The investment seeks long-term growth of capital by investing primarily in securities of companies that meet the fund's financial criteria and social policy. The fund invests mainly in common stocks of mid- to large-capitalization companies. It seeks to reduce risk by investing across many different industries. The fund looks for solid balance sheets, strong management teams with a track record of success, good cash flow, the prospect for above average earnings growth, and other valuation-related factors.

**Davis NY Venture Fund Class A - MC: Large Blend** The investment seeks long-term growth of capital. The fund invests the majority of the assets in equity securities issued by large companies with market capitalizations of at least \$10 billion. It has the flexibility to invest a limited portion of assets in companies of any size, to invest in companies whose shares may be subject to controversy, to invest in foreign securities, and to invest in non-equity securities.

**VT Fidelity Contrafund® - MC: Large Growth** The investment seeks capital appreciation. The fund normally invests primarily in common stocks. It may invest in securities of companies whose value is not fully recognized by the public. The fund invests in both domestic and foreign issuers. It may invest in "growth" stocks or "value" stocks or both. The advisor uses fundamental analysis of each issuer's financial condition and industry position and market and economic conditions to select investments.

**American Funds Growth Fund of America R4 - MC: Large Growth** The investment seeks capital growth by investing in common stocks. The fund invests primarily in common stocks and seeks to invest in companies that appear to offer superior opportunities for growth of capital. It may also hold cash or money market instruments. The fund may invest up to 25% of its assets in securities of issuers domiciled outside the United States.

**VT Royce Premier Fund Class Service - MC: Mid-Cap Blend** The investment seeks long-term growth of capital. The Fund invests at least 80% of its net assets in the equity securities of "premier" companies. At least 65% of these securities will be issued by companies with stock market capitalizations up to \$2.5 billion at the time of investment. The fund may invest up to 25% of assets in the securities of foreign issuers. The fund looks for companies it considers "premier" that have excellent business strengths and/

or prospects for growth, high internal rates of return and low leverage, and that are trading significantly below estimates of their current worth.

**Vanguard Mid-Cap Index Fund Class Signal - MC: Mid-Cap Blend** The investment seeks to track the performance of a benchmark index that measures the investment return of mid-capitalization stocks. The fund employs a passive management investment approach designed to track the performance of the MSCI US Mid Cap 450 index, a broadly diversified index of the stocks of medium-size U.S. companies. It attempts to replicate the target index by investing all, or substantially all, of assets in the stocks that make up the index, holding each stock in approximately the same proportion as its weighting in the index.

**Columbia Acorn Class A - MC: Mid-Cap Growth** The investment seeks long-term capital appreciation. The fund normally invests a majority of net assets in small- and mid-sized companies with market capitalizations under \$5 billion at the time of investment. It invests the majority of assets in U.S. companies, but also may invest up to 33% of total assets in foreign companies in developed markets and in emerging markets.

**VT Rainier Small/Mid Cap Equity Fund - MC: Mid-Cap Growth** The investment seeks to maximize long-term capital appreciation. The fund normally invests at least 80% of assets in the common stock of small- and mid-capitalization companies traded in the U.S. with prospects of strong earnings growth and attractive overall business fundamentals, selling at reasonable valuations.

**VT T. Rowe Price® Small Cap Value Fund Class Adv - MC: Small Blend** The investment seeks long-term capital growth. The fund will invest at least 80% of assets in companies with a market capitalization that is within or below the range of companies in the Russell 2000 index. While it invests most assets in U.S. common stocks, the fund may also purchase other securities including bonds, foreign stocks, futures, and options.

**Vanguard Small Cap Index Fund Class Signal - MC: Small Blend** The investment seeks to track the performance of a benchmark index that measures the investment return of small capitalization stocks. The fund employs a passive management investment approach designed to track the performance of the MSCI US Small Cap 1750 index, a broadly diversified index of the stocks of smaller U.S. companies. It attempts to replicate the target index by investing all, or

substantially all, of assets in the stocks that make up the index, holding each stock in approximately the same proportion as its weighting in the index.

**BlackRock Small Cap Growth Equity Fund Class Service - MC: Small Growth** The investment seeks long-term capital appreciation. The fund normally invests at least 80% of assets in equities issued by U.S. small-capitalization companies whose market capitalizations within the range of market capitalizations of companies in the Russell 2000 Growth index. It primarily buys common stock but also can invest in preferred stock and securities convertible into common and preferred stock. The Fund may invest in shares of companies through initial public offerings (IPOs).

**Cohen and Steers Realty Shares - MC: Real Estate** The investment seeks total return with equal emphasis on capital appreciation and current income. The fund invests primarily at least 80%, and normally substantially all of assets in equity securities of real-estate companies. These securities may consist of common stocks, rights or warrants to purchase common stocks, convertible securities, and preferred stocks. It may invest without limit in shares of real-estate investment trusts. The fund may invest up to 20% of assets in securities of foreign real-estate companies. It is nondiversified.

#### **INTERNATIONAL STOCK FUNDS**

**American Funds Capital World Growth and Income Fund Class R4 - MC: World Stock** The investment seeks long-term growth of capital while providing current income. The fund invests, on a global basis, in common stocks that are denominated in U.S. dollars or other currencies. It may also hold cash or money market instruments.

**Third Avenue Value Fund - MC: World Stock** The investment seeks long-term capital appreciation. The fund invests in common stocks of well-financed companies at a discount to what the Adviser believes is their true value. It may invest in companies of any market capitalization. The fund also seeks to acquire senior securities, such as debt instruments (including high-yield and distressed securities that may be in default and may have any or no credit rating) that the Adviser believes are undervalued. It is nondiversified.

**Oppenheimer International Growth Fund - MC: Foreign Large Growth** The investment seeks long-term capital appreciation. The fund invests mainly in common stocks of growth companies that are domiciled outside the U.S. or have their primary operations outside the U.S. It invests at least 65% of total assets in common and preferred stocks of issuers in at least

three different countries outside of the United States, and emphasizes investments in common stocks of issuers that the portfolio manager considers to be "growth" companies. The fund does not limit its investments to issuers within a specific market capitalization range.

**VT Fidelity Diversified International Fund - MC: Foreign Large Growth** The investment seeks capital appreciation. The fund normally invests in non-U.S. securities. It primarily invests in common stocks and allocates investments across countries and regions while considering the size of the market relative to size of the international market as a whole.

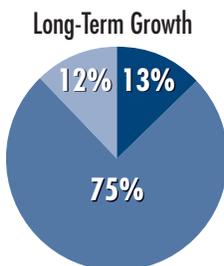
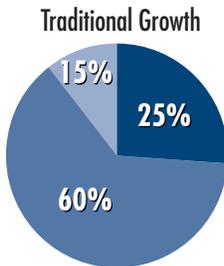
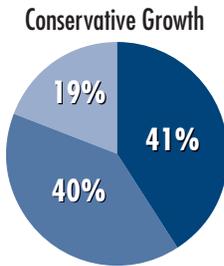
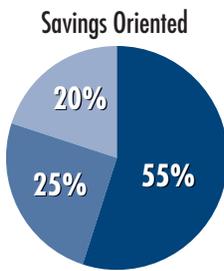
**Oppenheimer Developing Markets Fund Class A - MC: Diversified Emerging Mkts** The investment aggressively seeks capital appreciation. The fund normally invests at least 80% of assets plus borrowings for investment purposes, in equity securities of issuers whose principal activities are in at least three developing markets. It may at times invest up to 100% of its total assets in foreign securities. The fund emphasizes investments in growth companies which can be in any market capitalization range.

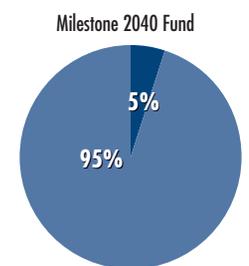
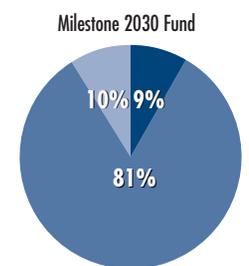
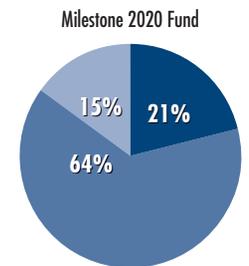
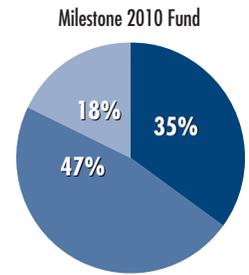
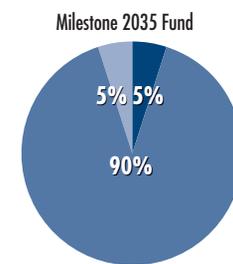
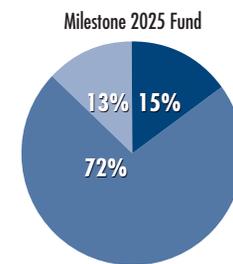
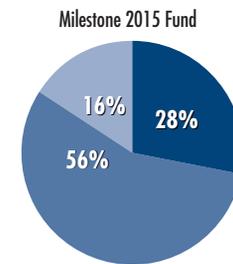
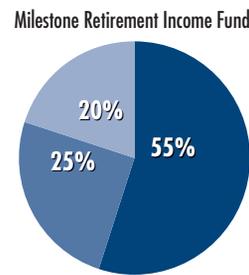
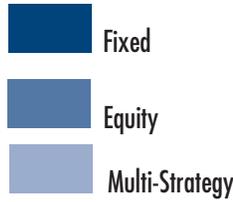
### Representative Asset Allocation for Vantagepoint Model Portfolio Funds
