PURPOSE:

Utility Reconnects required per City of Tucson, Tucson Electric Power and Southwest Gas

POLICY:

Electrical Reconnects: All electric power shut off for more than two (2) months Commercial and six (6) months Residential must be permitted and inspected by the City of Tucson. The cost of the permit is charged as one inspection charge per utility connection. not to exceed 4 connections per permit. Separate permits are required for separate buildings.

Gas Reconnects: The City of Tucson will issue a gas reconnect permit if requested by Southwest Gas and the applicant on any property that has not had recent gas service. The cost of the permit is charged as one inspection charge per utility connection, not to exceed 4 connections per permit. Separate permits are required for separate buildings. The applicant is required to provide and install the gas pressure test apparatus prior to the inspection.

All addresses are subject to the EXPIRED permit policy, which prevents any permit from being issued to an address that has an expired permit.
