RESOLUTION NO. PHA2026-54

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING; RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE CITY OF TUCSON REVISED UTILITY ALLOWANCE SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2026; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Tucson operates Public Housing Authority (PHA) programs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations (24 CFR 965.207) require Public Housing Authorities (PHAs) to review their utility allowance schedule annually and adjust the schedule if there has been a 10% increase or decrease in utility rate and charges since the last revision; and

WHEREAS, the City's PHA is responsible for the annual review and establishment of utility allowances of tenant-paid utilities; and

WHEREAS, the City conducted its annual utility allowance review in October 2025, which indicated that utility providers' rates have changed more than 10% therefore, the City's Housing Community and Development Department (HCD) recommends the revised utility allowance schedule as reflected in the utility allowance sheets; and

WHEREAS, having completed all HUD-required steps, action is needed by the Board of Commissioners to adopt the updated utility allowance schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby approves and adopts the revised utility allowance schedule as presented in Exhibit A to take effect on July 1, 2026.

SECTION 2. The PHA is hereby authorized to implement the revised utility allowance schedule as required by the Federal Assistance Programs.

SECTION 3. It is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Tucson that this Resolution become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.


