REZONING – ORDINANCE ADOPTION, C9-21-14 THE PLACE AT MASON RANCH PHASE II – TANQUE VERDE ROAD, SR TO R-3 (WARD 2)

This is a request by the Planning Center for an ordinance to rezone approximately 3.6 acres from SR to R-3 zoning. The rezoning site is located approximately 500 feet north



of Tanque Verde Road and 700 feet west of Bear Canyon Road. The preliminary development plan (PDP) proposes 56 new apartment units in two-story buildings as Phase II of The Place at Mason Ranch, a multifamily apartment community. The adjacent 16.12-acre Phase 1 project area, located to the north and east of the rezoning site is currently zoned R-3. The total project site area, including both phases, is 19.75 acres, with a total of 312 apartment units proposed.

REZONING – ORDINANCE ADOPTION, C9-19-10 CORBETT – 29TH STREET, R-1 TO R-2 (WARD 6)

This is a request by Pepper Viner Investment Co II LLC for an ordinance to rezone approximately 6.88 acres from R-1 to R-2 zoning. The rezoning site is located on the northeast corner of 29th Street and Sahuara Avenue The applicant is developing a single-family residential subdivision of 71 lots, with 12 guest parking spaces, and a density of 10.34 (RAC).
