Apply for a '**Fire Special Event Permit – Vendor**' permit on the Tucson Development Center Online (TDC) at: <https://tdc-online.tucsonaz.gov/#/home> no later than **30 days** prior to the scheduled display.

NOTE: Read and follow the directions throughout the application. Missing information will result in application refusal.

The following information must be attached to the permit application:

- A completed **1.3 Fireworks Display Information** sheet.
- A copy of a government issued photo ID (front and back) of the pyrotechnic operator conducting the display.
- A copy of the **Certificate of Liability Insurance** for a minimum of five million dollars with the City of Tucson listed as additional insured, with a Waiver of Subrogation. See '[Special Event Insurance Requirements](#)'.
- A copy of the head operator's certification issued by the Tucson Fire Department or other AHJ if approved by TFD.
- A detailed **Site Plan** depicting the exact placement of the fireworks, the fall-out area, as well as setback distances to the audience, structures, overhead lines, roadways, access points, or any type of combustible material.
- A **product listing** of fireworks to be used including the number, size, and type.
- An **MSDS** for each type of pyrotechnic material to be used.
- A **Safety Plan**.

It is at the discretion of the Tucson Fire Department to verify the documentation provided in the permit application packet for compliance. Incomplete packets or packets submitted late may be cause for denial of a permit.
