Regulation of Tabloid Vending Machines (City-Wide) SS/AUG30-99-394</p> <p>Council Member Ibarra MOVED, SECONDED by Council Member Anderson, that:</p> <p>A.) the City Attorney be directed to return to Mayor and Council within 90 days with options available to restrict the sale of material considered to be harmful to minors from publicly accessible vending machines. The options include the drafting of an ordinance restricting such sales, seeking an injunction against such sales, and requesting permission, in appropriate circumstances, from the Pima County Attorney for the City Attorney to prosecute the distributors of such material as misdemeanors under current state law.</p> <p>B. As part of this motion, the Chief of Police is requested to investigate advertisements appearing in tabloids being publicly distributed that appear to be obvious solicitations for acts of prostitution.</p> <p>C.
