5. Southern Arizona Delegation Legislative Discussion

Mayor Gordon Van Camp, Town of Sahuarita, suggested each jurisdiction consider the information presented, formulate priorities, and develop a strategy for recommendations to be discussed at the next joint meeting.

There was apparent consensus.

Council Member Wayne Bryant, Town of Oro Valley, requested the next joint meeting take place prior to the beginning of the next legislative session.

Council Member Ronstadt, City of Tucson, suggested that given the time constraints the next joint meeting be scheduled in mid-January.

There was apparent consensus.

Council Member Scott, City of Tucson, urged all bodies to endorse the Neighborhood Preservation Investment Initiative.

Vice-Mayor, Dick Johnson, Oro Valley, requested that the State Legislators give special consideration to the impact their decisions make at the local level.

Council Member Wayne Bryant, Oro Valley, raised two questions:

- 1) Are the local bodies present amending future budgets to absorb a proposed reduction in the vehicle license tax?
- 2) Can the State change the State Shared Rate without going to the voters?

Council Member West, City of Tucson, requested the Regional Transportation Plan be included in the League of Cities agenda and be reviewed.
