## NOMINATION OTHER THAN BY PRIMARY SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS

A candidate who seeks election by the "Nomination Other Than By Primary" process must collect valid signatures equal to at least three percent of the total number of registered voters who are not members of a qualified political party. For Mayoral candidates, the total is calculated using the total number of registered voters in the City of Tucson. For Council Members, the total is calculated using the total number of registered voters in the ward for which the candidate is seeking office. According to state law, the number of valid signatures required on Nomination Other Than By Primary petitions will be based on the voter registration figures for the City of Tucson as of March 1, 2011.
