NEW 2015 LIMITS ON CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS TO CANDIDATES (per Campaign Period*)		
\$500	Maximum contribution from an individual	Tucson Charter, Chapter XVI, Subchapter A, Sec. 2
\$1,000	Maximum contribution from political committees	Tucson Charter, Chapter XVI, Subchapter A, Sec. 2
\$5,000	Maximum contribution from a "Super PAC"	A.R.S. § 16-905 (A)(5)
\$11,390	Maximum cumulative contribution to a nominee from all Political Parties and Political Organizations combined	A.R.S. § 16-905 (D)
\$500	Maximum contribution from a Family Member to a Public Funding Candidate	Tucson Charter, Chapter XVI, Subchapter A, Sec. 2
---	Family Contributions for non-Public Funding Candidates are considered "Personal Monies" of the Candidate	A.R.S. § 16-901 (10) and (18)(d)

*Pursuant to the Tucson Charter, Chapter XVI and the Tucson Code Chapter 12-110, campaign period means the entire time from the date on which an individual becomes a candidate until the election or defeat of the candidate. The campaign period ends on the date the Mayor and Council canvass and declare the results of the election at which the candidate is elected or defeated.
