

Scott Avenue improvement project making progress

Work on Scott Avenue in downtown Tucson continues with crews focusing on completing curb and driveway improvements near the Pima County Parking Garage.

Crews are scheduled to complete the following work:

- Concrete curb installation along east Scott Avenue.
- Installation of middle driveway and drainage at the Pima County Parking Garage. Access to the parking garage will be maintained.
- Additional improvement work adjacent to the Pima County Parking Garage.

Crews are scheduled to work weekdays from 6 a.m. until 2:30 p.m., although some evening work may be required for paving operations.

Southbound travel on Scott Avenue between Pennington and Congress streets will remain closed for the duration of the project, which is scheduled to be completed in late October.

The project will include installation of five new streetlights, improved landscaping including planter boxes in locations, replacement of sidewalks, extension of roof drains from adjacent buildings and drainage improvements in the project area.
