How it Works!

- 1. Fill up your bag with all your non-recyclable plastic waste. Clear or transparent bag is recommended.
- Drop off the bag in the <u>orange</u> 22 cubic yard roll-off containers located at either of the locations noted below. They are marked **PLASTIC ONLY**. The City of Tucson Environmental & General Services (ESGD) will pick up the full roll-off container regularly.

We manage non-recyclable plastics and use them as construction material. See what we have built at San Gabriel Neighborhood Park, Himmel Park, El Pueblo Health Center, Ward 6 office, and more to come.




Tucson is Blocking Plastic Waste for Good!
