RESOLUTION NO. 24118

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION AND MOBILITY; ADOPTING THE PROPOSED RATES AND FEES CHARGED BY THE CITY OF TUCSON'S (CITY) DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND MOBILITY (DTM); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCSON, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the DTM revised rates and fees for Right of Way Permits, new rates and fees for Loss of Use Fees and Loss of Value Fees (related to Pavement Degradation and Cuts) as reflected in Exhibit B, is adopted and approved.

SECTION 2. The revised rates and fees for Right of Way Permits will be effective July 1, 2026.

SECTION 3. The new DTM Loss of Use Fees will be implemented in a phased approach: 33 percent in the first fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026; 66 percent in the second year; and 100 percent in the third year, as set forth in Exhibit B.

SECTION 3. Implementation of the Loss of Use Fee will also approve the Business Support Program.

SECTION 4. The DTM Loss of Value Fee will be subject to moratorium requirements and will be implemented over three years as set forth in Exhibit B.

SECTION 5. Implementation of the Loss of Value fee will also approve the Pavement Preservation Program.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk is directed to file the subject Mayor and Council Communication and all attachments thereto as the report supporting the revised and new rates and fees.

SECTION 7. The various City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this Resolution.

SECTION 8. WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Tucson that this Resolution become immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
