About the RTA

RTA Overview

- The Regional Transportation Authority is an independent taxing district within Pima County.
- Voters approved the 20-year RTA plan in 2006.
- To date, the RTA has invested over \$1.6 billion generated by the RTA's half-cent excise tax to improve quality of life and support the region's economic vitality

Under Construction: Valencia, Kolb to Houghton

Project Overview

- Construction on the south side of Valencia Road since July 2025.
- Crews are forming the median curb and grading the roadway for future paving.
- Progress being made on underground infrastructure.
- Estimated Completion: Mid-2026

DTM WARD 4 UPDATES

Upcoming: Houghton Road, 22nd to Irvington

Project Overview

- Improvements extend just south of the 22nd Street intersection to immediately north of the Irvington Road intersection and includes bridges at the Pantano Wash.
- Utility work is taking place before roadway improvements
- Construction anticipated to begin: Late 2026
- Public Pre-Construction Open House: Prior to Construction

DTM WARD 4 UPDATES

Upcoming: 22nd, Camino Seco to Houghton

Project Overview

- Widen 22nd Street to a four-lane divided roadway.
- Planned improvements include pedestrian facilities, bike lanes, raised median islands, street lighting, and native landscaping.
- Construction anticipated to begin: 2027

Upcoming: Harrison Road Bridge

Project Overview

- A new two-lane bridge will be built over the Pantano Wash
- Drainage improvements to provide all-weather access to commuters.
- Construction anticipated to begin: Early 2027


About Prop 411

- Extends a 10-year half-cent sales tax funding neighborhood street improvements and systemwide street safety projects.



About Collector Streets

Overview

- Five-year, city-funded initiative approved as part of Prop 411.
- Targets mid-level roadways connecting neighborhood streets to major arterials.

Sarnoff Drive


Project Overview

- Part of the Collector Street Program, which coordinates resurfacing and safety upgrades.
- Safety improvements include:
 - Speed calming measures (speed humps)
 - Enhanced striping and pavement markings
 - Center curbed pedestrian areas
 - Flexible plastic bollards




FY 2024-2027 Collector St. Program

About Prop 407

Overview

- Voter-approved in 2018.
- \$225 million bond package to improve City parks amenities and connections.

Andrew Street Bicycle Boulevard

Project Overview

- Creates an east/west route to jobs, neighborhood destinations, schools, and parks.
- Planned and funded project extends along a 5.6 miles from Tucson Boulevard to Wilmot Road between 22nd Street and 29th Street.
- Construction anticipated to begin: Early 2026
