- Himmel Park -Entire Park
- Jacobs Park/Ochoa Soccer Complex - Ramada #3
- Kennedy Park - Ramadas #8 thru #29
- Lakeside Park - Ramada #1, #2, #3, #4
- Silverlake Park - Entire park
