MILESTONE PROJECTS

Bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad – Project completed in early 2019
– Two-lane bridge replaced with two 3-lane bridges that include bike lanes and sidewalks in each direction.

Union Pacific Railroad to Interstate 10 – Project completed fall 2019
The 1.2-mile segment includes six travel lanes, bike lanes in each direction, a multiuse path, drainage improvements, water harvesting and native plant landscaping.

The Regional Transportation Authority is a special taxing district with a mission to deliver multimodal transportation projects that improve our region's mobility, safety and environment. The district's voters approved the 20-year RTA plan in 2006. To date, the RTA has invested over \$1.2 billion generated by the RTA's half-cent excise tax within Pima County to improve your quality of life and support the region's economic vitality.
