Preconstruction Meeting for Euclid Avenue/Park Avenue Bicycle-Pedestrian Overpass

The City of Tucson Department of Transportation (TDOT) invites you to a pre-construction public meeting on an upcoming bicycle/pedestrian improvement project in your neighborhood.

At the meeting you will be able to review the plans and learn the construction schedule for the Euclid Avenue/Park Avenue Bicycle-Pedestrian Overpass. The work consists of construction of a 240' bicycle/pedestrian overpass structure over Euclid Avenue just north of SR-210 Aviation Parkway. The project will connect the existing bike path at the Park Avenue/14th Street cul-de-sac to the existing path west of Euclid Avenue, which connects to the existing Diamondback Bridge over Broadway. This project will include retaining walls, sound walls, artwork, pathway and bridge lighting, landscaping and irrigation.

Construction is scheduled to begin early February 2007 with completion in October 2007, weather permitting. Please join us on:
