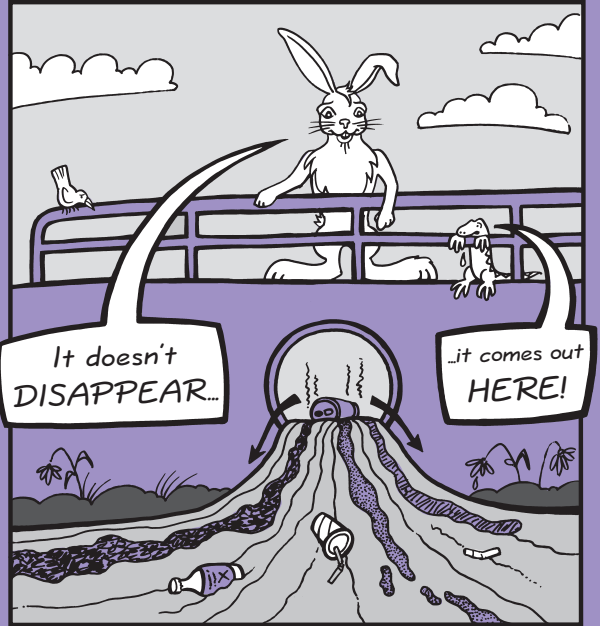


STORMDRAINS LEAD TO WASHES!
