

Scott Avenue improvement work winds down this week

With paving complete on Scott Avenue between Congress and Pennington streets in downtown Tucson, crews will spend this week working on landscaping and cleaning up the project area.

The City of Tucson project, which began with utility improvements and included work to beautify the streetscape and improve both the roadway and sidewalks, is nearly complete.

The project area is still closed to southbound traffic on Scott Avenue and only right turns are permitted out of the Pennington Street Garage.

Scott Avenue motorists wishing to travel westward will need to continue north to Alameda Street. Right turns onto eastbound Pennington Street will be allowed.

Access to all businesses will be maintained during the remainder of the work.

Crews are scheduled to work weekdays from 6 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.

The project includes installation of five new streetlights, improved landscaping including planter boxes, replacement of sidewalks, extension of roof drains from adjacent buildings and drainage improvements in the project area.
