NIGHT WORK PLANNED

Tucson Water has authorized Granite Construction to make water main modifications to a large diameter water main in Broadway Boulevard. This work is separate from the road improvement contract and will provide Tucson Water the ability to better shut down portions of their water system without affecting customers in the future. This work will be done at night. Night work schedule is as follows:

Sunday, October 7, 2007	5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
Monday, October 8, 2007	9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
Tuesday, October 9, 2007	7:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon

LANE RESTRICTIONS DURING WATER MODIFICATION WORK

Unfortunately, the water main work is in the middle of the Broadway Boulevard and Harrison Road intersection. Both Broadway Boulevard and Harrison Road will have to be restricted to one lane in each direction during this time. Both directions of traffic will be shifted to the east side of Harrison Road beginning Sunday October 7th to Tuesday afternoon October 9th until the work is completed. Please follow the traffic control and signing while the lane restrictions are in effect.

PAVING UPDATE

The final paving date has been accelerated. The work to place the final layer of 1-1/2 inches of asphalt rubber will begin Monday, October 15th. The paving crew will begin by filling in the sidestreet approaches and driveways. Crews will then work to complete Harrison Road from Speedway Boulevard to Old Spanish Trail beginning October 17th. Work will begin along the inner lanes. Traffic will be shifted to the new pavement while the inside lanes are completed. Broadway Boulevard will be paved in its entirety on Monday, October 22nd.

TRAFFIC CHANGE DURING PAVING

One lane of traffic in each direction will temporarily be provided on Harrison Road and on Broadway Boulevard while the paving is being done. Both of the new lanes on Broadway Boulevard and Harrison Road will be opened to traffic as soon as reasonably possible.
