George cut an ad for me in my first campaign, for which I was grateful. More than a 30 second ad, though, I valued his wisdom and his work for the community as a veteran, teacher and office holder.

George's life of service over the course of seven decades provides an example that I and my colleagues strive to emulate every day, and I hope we continue to do so.
