**Lotus Massage & Wellness Center**

Laura Key, owner and manager of Lotus Massage & Wellness Center, exemplifies how a small business can make an important contribution to water efficiency, even if opportunities are not on the same scale of a large, commercial water customer.

The center's building is 1,450 square feet with modest outdoor landscaping. However, its two toilets are 1.6 gallon flush models, the sink aerators are low-flow, and rainwater is directed as much as possible to irrigate the desert-adapted plants and trees outside.



The nature of the massage and wellness profession also means that laundry service is an essential component of daily operation. Though this water isn't used at the site, staff chose the wash-and-fold services of [Campbell Coin Laundry and Cleaners](#) because of its commitment to environmental responsibility.
