### **WB 22<sup>nd</sup> St., Alvernon to Randolph, Remains Closed Due to Water Main Break**

(1400 hours) Westbound 22nd St., from Alvernon Way to Randolph Way, remains closed to through traffic due to a water main break that took place on Monday, Feb. 29. Westbound traffic is being routed north and south on Alvernon. Right turns from southbound Alvernon and left turns from northbound Alvernon are not permitted at the 22<sup>nd</sup> St. intersection.

Tucson Water and contractor crews expect that the first phase of repairs to the 63-year-old, 30-inch water main pipe will be completed by Friday afternoon, Mar. 4. Southbound traffic on Alvernon will then be allowed to turn west on 22<sup>nd</sup> St. However, additional restrictions at that intersection for scheduled replacement of a 36-inch water main will go into effect beginning Friday, March 4, until Monday, Mar. 7. That information will be available on Mar. 3.

The break has not affected water service to customers. Motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians are reminded to use additional caution and be prepared for delays in the area.
