### **Emergency Water Line Work May Affect Water Pressure in Part of East Tucson**

(1200 hours) Tucson Water crews will be performing emergency water line work which may cause lower-than-normal water pressure for some customers in parts of east Tucson. This water line needs to be replaced as a result of nearby construction activity.

Work is to begin immediately. It is not known how long repairs will take.

The area affected is Tanque Verde / Wrightstown Roads on the north; Sarnoff Road on the east; Pima Street on the south; and Camino Pio Decimo on the west. Customers in this area may notice reduced pressure, but continue to have water service.

Motorists may see additional work crews near the area of Tanque Verde and Wrightstown Roads and are asked to exercise additional caution while driving to help ensure worker safety.
