“Fix a Leak Week” Promotes Awareness of Water Leaks, Loss

Tucson Water and utilities across Arizona are partnering with the EPA’s WaterSense division to promote “Fix a Leak Week,” March 17-23, 2014, to remind people of the amount of water collectively lost through minor household leaks.

Tucson Water’s “Fix a Leak Week” web page at tucsonaz.gov/water/fix-leak-week has links to online calculators for measuring the impact of drips and leaks, “Family Fact Sheets” in English and Spanish for finding and fixing leaks, helpful videos from the Regional Water Providers Consortium, and an activity learning page for kids.

“There are a number of ways to check for a household water leak,” said Fernando Molina, Tucson Water Public Information Officer. “Drop a blue dye tab in a toilet tank. If the bowl water also turns blue, the toilet flapper is leaking. Make sure the water is turned off in the house, then check the water meter for any movement. These are things homeowners can do on a regular basis.”
